

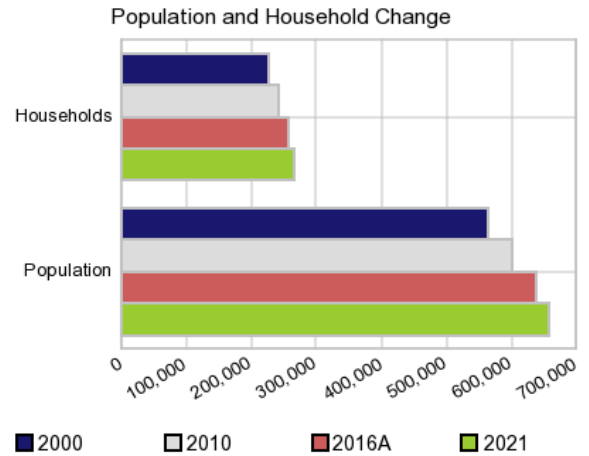
Executive Summary with Charts

Population Demographics:

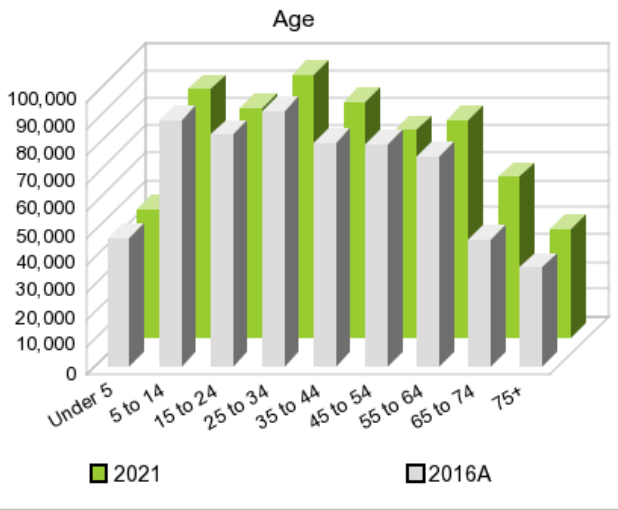
The number of households in the study area in 2000 was **226,904** and changed to **241,737** in 2010, representing a change of **6.5%**. The household count in 2016A was **257,011** and the household projection for 2021 is **265,471**, a change of **3.2%**.

The population in the study area in 2000 was **563,322** and in 2010 it was **603,403**, roughly a **7.1%** change. The population in 2016A was **639,428** and the projection for 2021 is **657,782** representing a change of **2.8%**.

Population by Age



In 2000, the median age of the total population in the study area was **34.5**, and in 2010, it was **35.1**. The median age in 2016A is **35.3** and it is predicted to change in five years to **36.2** years. In 2016A, females represented **51.2%** of the population with a median age of **36.6** and males represented **48.7%** of the population with a median age of **34.2** years. In 2016A, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 25 to 34** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **Age 75 +** years.

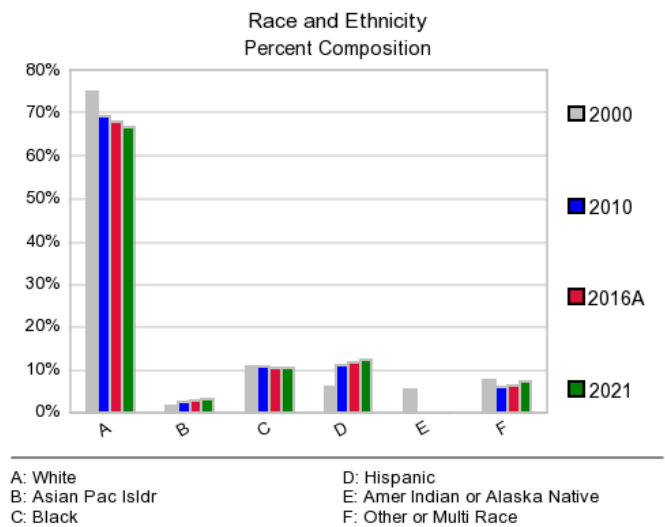

Population by Race/Ethnicity



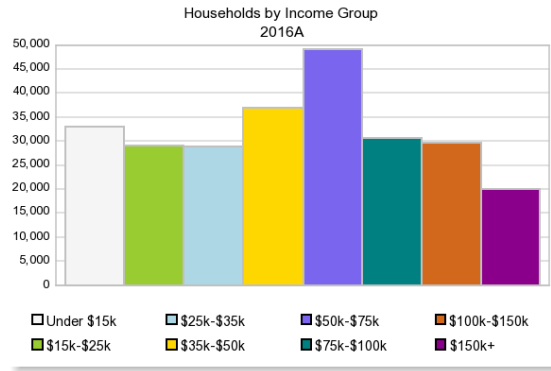
In 2016A, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **White**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **Asian or Pacific Islander**.
